**MOST HOLY BODY AND
BLOOD OF CHRIST...**

Today, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. Originating in the liturgical calendar in the 13th Century, today's feast day is a combination of two separate feast days of the Body of Christ and another day in honor of the Blood of Christ.

On this day, in some cultures and traditions, the Church holds a procession of the Blessed Sacrament through the streets. Akin to the procession with the Blessed Sacrament on Holy Thursday, the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, this procession, with the Sacrament in a Monstrance, is a visible sign of Christ's triumphant presence in the Church. It is our Catholic belief in the Real Presence of the Lord; Christ is truly present to us in His Body in His Blood. His Body which he sacrificed for us, in His Blood which washed away our sins.

As we celebrate this Solemnity, I think a question to reflect upon is our own appreciation of the gift of the Lord: how do I/you truly express our devotion and participation in the Eucharist? While we say and believe in the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ - in what demonstrable way do we show our faith and belief in this awesome gift from God?

A Father and His Children...

When my children were teenagers, I had been working at my home parish for about eight years. During that time, I was going to school part-time for my Bachelor's Degree. I also would take an occasional one-day workshop or seminar that was a necessary part of my development in ministry. Then one day an opportunity arose for me to attend a more lengthy seminar in Saginaw, Michigan that started on Friday and ended Sunday. Wow! I thought, three days. How exciting! When I made the announcement of my proposed trip at dinner that night, you would have thought I just told my family I was going off to Siberia never to be heard from again!

So, what I tried to do was to make sure that my absence was felt as painlessly as possible. I left a list of phone numbers where I could be reached in case of an emergency (did you wash my white blouse?), extra money at home, and a generous supply of lunch meat, milk, and goodies (heaven forbid someone should have to run to the store!).

There was one thing I left, however, that wasn't as well received - Dad in charge!! (I heard the cries and moans for miles). That is something that my family was not very good at, dealing with Dad **and** with each other without me as the buffer. I was actually a little nervous about leaving them (but not nervous enough to cancel!). I even tried to think ahead on what situations might arise and offer possible solutions to all sides involved to ease the tension.

But then, I realized these were the same children and father who **drove** to California on a family vacation and survived. They shared a tiny six foot by six foot space, breathed the same air, even sat next to each other for

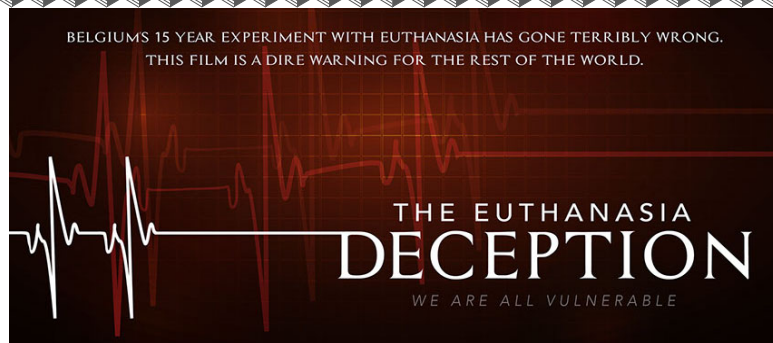
sometimes ten hours at a stretch, and lived to tell about it, brag about it even. They went to Disneyland together, on the Universal Studio tour together, and drove on those California freeways together!! So as I left, I reminded them of that, and reminded them that just as God loves us and has patience with us, they should love each other and have patience with each other as well. They all shuffled their feet a bit, looked down, around and up before making eye contact and then sheepishly agreed, each one absolutely sure in their heart that **THEY** would be the one making the biggest sacrifice in getting along!

I knew then that they would be all right and that this would end up being a time of maturing for them all. Often, because Mom is always around, children develop a special relationship with her because of her continual presence and the constant communication that goes on. But, because fathers are away from home most of the day, sometimes work overtime, or are just plain beat when they come home, his relationship with his children doesn't develop in the same way. Not that it's non-existent, it just needs a little more time and attention to become as beneficial as mom's relationship.

I looked at my weekend away as one of those opportunities for development and I must say they did beautifully. Well, okay, maybe not 'beautifully,' but at least they were still talking to each other when I finally got home!

I WISH ALL FATHERS AND THOSE THAT LOVE AND SUPPORT OTHERS WITH A FATHER'S LOVE, A VERY HOLY AND SPECIAL FATHER'S DAY. May the Lord continue to fill you with wisdom and love as we experience God's own fatherly love for us through you.

Registration materials for the 2017-18 Religious Education classes have been mailed. Both new and returning families need to register for next year. For 2017-18, we will continue to offer our regular Catechetical sessions which begin after Labor Day and end in May, 2018. The deadline for returning your completed registration with payment is June 30.

Tuition must be paid in full at the time of registration. We accept cash or checks made payable to *St. Julie*. All credit card payments or direct debit from your checking or savings account are only available on-line, through the website, using *Faith Direct*.

The Religious Education program is for children in Preschool thru 8th Grades who attend the public district schools. This program is developmental, which means that the children are expected to attend ALL levels in order to be fully initiated and formed into the life of the Church. 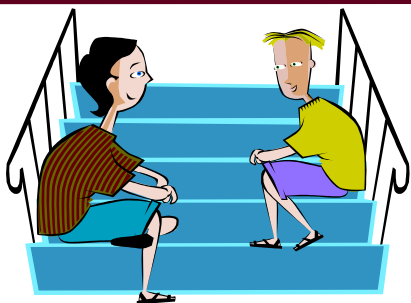
