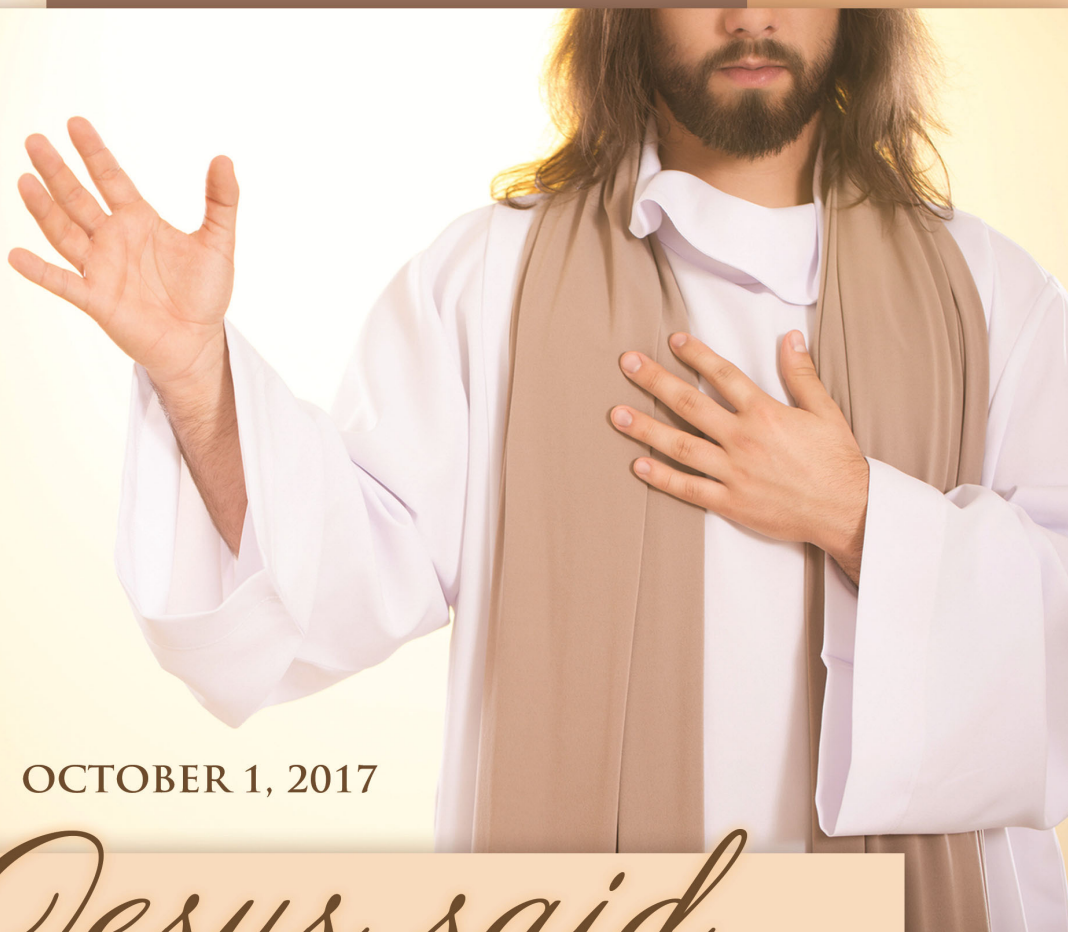

DIACONATE CANDIDACY...

This afternoon, John Benz will formally declare his candidacy to the Diaconate! John and his wife, Kathy, are long time parishioners of St. Julie and for the past year they have been a part of the aspirancy program to discern John's vocation to the Diaconate. John is one of 27 men who will go through this rite of the Church as their first official recognition of their calling to Holy Orders in Order of Deacon. Our hope is that over the next three years of discernment and formation, John's vocation will be confirmed and will lead him to ordination. These years of preparation include academic studies, spiritual formation and direction, pastoral ministry experiences to name but a few aspects. We pray for John and Kathy, their cohort in formation and their families as they take this important step in their journey in serving the Church.

Communion Pattern Change

Beginning this weekend, our communion **procession to the cup** will be slightly altered. The chart below shows **ONLY** the **new positions for the Ministers of the Chalice**. All current Bread Ministers will remain at the same stations where they currently stand.

By moving the Chalice Ministers back and spreading them out a little from each other, our hope is that those receiving from the Chalice will not impede the procession's flow of those who are receiving from the Bread Minister only. Of course, you will still have the option to go to an open minister if your line is too long.

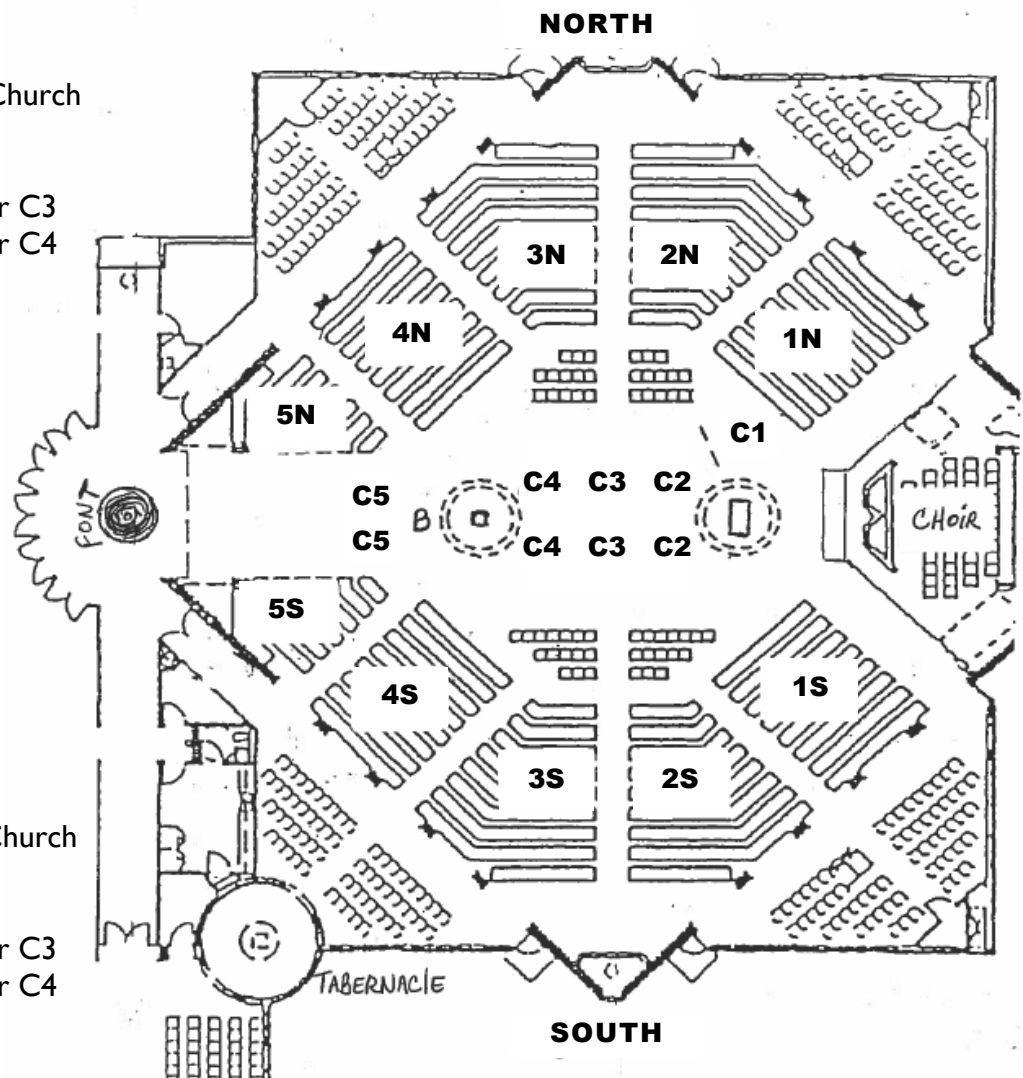
Our goal is always focused on the unity of our assembly as we process together to receive the Body and Blood of Christ. Please be patient over the next few weeks as we learn the new pattern for our Communion Procession, as we worship the Lord and gather as one.

Here is the pattern for those receiving from the Chalice on the **NORTH SIDE** of the Church

- 1N Chalice Minister C1
- 2N Chalice Minister C2 or C3
- 3N Chalice Minister C3 or C4
- 4N Chalice Minister C4
- 5N* Chalice Minister C5

Here is the pattern for those receiving from the Chalice on the **SOUTH SIDE** of the Church

- 1S Chalice Minister C2
- 2S Chalice Minister C2 or C3
- 3S Chalice Minister C3 or C4
- 4S Chalice Minister C4
- 5S* Chalice Minister C5



*Please note that Section 5, both North and South, can now process together to receive the Body and Blood of Christ simultaneously.

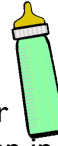

The Second Pillar of Islam: Prayer

The second pillar of Islam is Salat, the constant remembrance of God in prayer. Salat is a ritual worship prayer performed five times a day, corresponding to the important transitional times of the day (dawn, noon, afternoon, sunset and night). Salat includes the recitation of the Qur'an, accompanied by body movements, that Muslims perform alone, with their families or in community. In this prayer, Muslims recall and recite the divine guidance embodied in the Qur'an and hope to gradually attune themselves to the will of God. Salat is distinguished from supplication or invocation for God's help that is spontaneous in nature and can be performed at any time or in any place. This is called Du'a and highlights a Muslim's total dependence on the beneficence of God for everything. Above all, both Salat and Du'a serve as integral elements on the way of total submission to God.

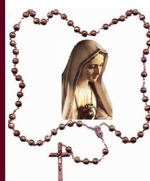
